- We created two 1x1m artworks over 3 workshops to build confidence in our creativity. These artworks will be displayed to promote the UN International Day for People with a Disability celebrated on December 3 each year.
- All Social Art Projects have three stages: **Messy Play, Exploration and BLING!** To consider one stage: in our Messy Play stage we used a variety of textured sponges to create visual interest as we dived into our creative confidence. We sponged around templates and used old gift cards as scrapers and then finished the stage by adding marks from our Mark Making Pattern Play.
- The result after three workshops and the contributions of 16 painters was this beautiful artwork above. It's perhaps important to note that members of Our Voice SA are the voice of people with an Intellectual Disability in South Australia - and you can see that everyone is creative, disability is not inability and *Art is for Everyone!*
